<p>New Business</p>	<p>Natalie Ivankovich, President</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Chromebook Fund: \$19K to purchase Chromebooks; since the Spring, some Chromebooks had to be e-wasted, District prioritizing secondary schools first in the 1:1 so elementary schools are last to get them from the district; 3-5 graders do have 1:1 Devices; Computer Lab is needed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Vote to release some of the money to fund a fully functional computer lab 1-2 grade or for any class that needs a lab setting for testing, etc. ○ \$276 per chromebook x32 = \$8,832 pre tax ○ Mrs. Perkins will have a technology committee meeting with a PTA rep there to discuss other options, explore higher tech than Chromebooks, before the November PTA meeting <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Thank you Matt for volunteering to attend that meeting ● Please take the Tech Survey if you haven’t already
