Teachers' Report	 ■ Reading Specialist - I am using the Fundations curriculum with the students in the Reading Lab. We are working on our phonics skills through building words, writing words/sentences, reading, and recognizing the different syllable types. We are also working on fluency and comprehension. I recently finished assessing 2nd grade students. Lastly, I presented at the last staff meeting-the topic was What is the Science of Reading? We focused on one area: phonics. This is something I hope to continue with the staff throughout the school year.
	TK - TK is enjoying all things gingerbread man. We are reading different versions of the gingerbread man and talking about how they are the same and different. We are also sequencing the story. We continue with our letter of the week and math skills through our daily stations which also include art and fine motor work. We are looking forward to our Winter Fest on Thursday with parent volunteers helping with stations.
	• 1st - Reviewing phonics, comprehension, and grammar skills this week. In math, we're learning strategies to subtract from teen numbers. In social studies we have been studying winter holidays around the world while discussing our own traditions. We're really enjoying our first grade art lessons led by Mrs. Foster and our parent volunteers.
	• 2nd - We are finishing module 4 adding and subtracting with regrouping. We will be doing measurement after the break. The students are doing a fabulous job on their heritage reports. We are learning about so many fun cultures, traditions, and family enjoyments, studying world geography, the students are presenting their heritage projects in class, and we are completing our second round of iReady. We are also learning about December holidays around the world.
	 3rd - Students are currently presenting self-made posters to teach each other about holidays around the world. It's our first "big" research assignment and presentation. Students are doing great and really rising to the occasion! We're wrapping up our math unit on estimation, rounding, and measurement. When we return from break, we're starting fractions!
	 4th - Making holiday projects, moving into long division and working on taking notes as we are gearing up for our large historical site research project

Volunteer Fair/Volunteer Days

- In the works to make it easier to get fingerprinted
- Idea: Volunteer Days (take a ½ day or whole day)

Computer Lab/Tech Committee Update

- 2-3 months of discussion re: funding a new computer lab with Chromeboxes
 - District rolling out 1:1 chromebooks to students (needs determined by survey so low turnout implies most parents have devices already)
 - 4-5th grade are 1:1
 - 2nd-3rd is almost 1:1
 - Chromebox lasts longer, has a monitor, keyboard, and mouse
 - Beneficial for K-1 younger students (QR code > login information)
 - Teachers prefer a dedicated space without the hurdles of logging in, plugin in, etc. 30-40 minutes estimated to be lost in the "commute"
 - o Foothill has a similar lab so this is prep for them
 - Wired preferred for stability (\$3,000 more) \$17,
- Spring 2020-2021 Fund-a-need for Chromebooks \$19,150
